On February 7, 2023, the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) published a restriction proposal submitted by the authorities of five EU countries —Germany, the Netherlands, Sweden, Denmark, and Norway—aimed at restricting the manufacture, use and placing on the market of over 10,000 per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS). This regulatory proposal will have a significant impact on the automotive sector and is a key priority for the Scania CV AB/Scania EU distributors. Addressing this matter is also in your best interest to ensure business continuity. Therefore, we urge you to take immediate actions in the following areas:

1. Monitor EU regulatory developments and available PFAS substitutes
 - Stay informed about regulatory updates related to the EU PFAS restriction.
 - Ensure that this topic is addressed across your supply chain as early as possible.
2. Investigate your supply chain and collect material data and PFAS information (preferably via International Material Data System (IMDS)) to ensure a sufficient understanding of the PFAS usage.

The restriction will additionally require suppliers to identify potential substitutes for PFAS containing materials. You may need to contact your suppliers regarding this matter.
